Summer Reading Program Guidelines

How do I join?

Sign up beginning Monday, June 21! Stop by the library and pick up a reading record and a list of our summer events. Investigate some great books and start reading! Register in person, by phone at 454-4524, or register online at www.salinalibrary.org.

How old do I have to be to join?

The Summer Reading Program is for preschoolers through kids entering 5th grade this fall. If you're entering 6th-12th grade, check out the library's Teen Reading Program.

What counts as reading?

You can read to yourself, to someone else or have someone read to you. You can read books, magazines, newspapers, comics, or listen to audio books.

How do I keep track of what I've read?

Please write down the names of the books you've read on your Reading Record. Write down the number of pages in the book if it's over 30. You'll get extra credit for longer books.

How do I report?

Turn in your Reading Record to a library staff member. We'd love to hear about some of the great books you've read! You may report once a week during the program. Saturday, August 7 is the last day to report.

How do I win prizes?

Win prizes by reading! Bring in your Reading Record each week and pick a prize from the treasure chest. If you've registered for the Summer Reading Program and turned in a Reading Record and read at least one book, you'll receive a certificate, and you can pick out one free book at the end of the program. You'll also be eligible for special weekly prize drawings!
