## 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Installed a new HVAC system thanks to a \$125,000 NYS CREST grant sponsored by Assemblywoman Pamela Hunter
- Awarded a grant from the Literacy Coalition of Onondaga County to support language learners through the Mango Languages app
- Opened the Community Fridge and Pantry with donations from Aldi, Byrne Dairy and local residents
- Continued popular trivia contest and Bingo events for adults
- Hosted the community holiday party for children and families
- Tabled at the Mattydale Market to spread the word about library services
- Offered Blast Off to Kindergarten, a fun program that helps parents prepare their preschool children for school
- Added new Toddlers Explore Storytime
- Hosted monthly art exhibits and artist receptions featuring local artists
- Loaned out passes to the Everson Museum of Art, Onondaga County Parks, NY State Parks, the MOST, and Splash Indoor Water Park
- Assisted 239 people with technology questions through the Tech Help By Appointment program

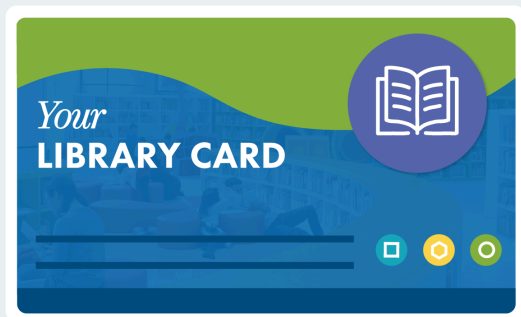
