Salina Library 2025-2029 Strategic Plan

INTRODUCTION

The Board of Trustees of the Salina Library is pleased to present our 2025-2029 Strategic Plan. Our strategic planning process engaged members of our community as well as library staff and trustees. An 11-question survey, available online as well as in paper form, primarily asked questions about library usage and services, with two questions centered on community concerns and communication of community events. Two open-ended, essay-type questions were essential to the survey, ensuring that survey takers weren't limited to only the topics covered by the multiple-choice questions.

We also facilitated a series of focus groups with members of the community that included library patrons, community advocates, and members of the community at large. Our focus group approach and questions were adapted from an initiative of the American Library Association and the Harwood Institute for Public Innovation that included the *Ask Tool*, which helped us to learn more about people's aspirations for the community. In these focus groups we asked only one library-specific question: "would you recommend Salina Library to others – and why or why not?" Library trustees and staff had their own meetings sharing their answers to the focus group questions, as well as reviewing community and library statistics and trends. Through this entire process we received invaluable feedback and information that became the foundation of our new five-year strategic plan.

Thank you to the community members, library staff, and library trustees who contributed to the creation of this strategic plan. We appreciate the trust and confidence the community has placed in their community library and look forward to enhancing the quality programs, services, and resources our process affirmed community members value.

- Offer more programs that provide information and activities to assist community members to be aware and knowledgeable about community issues

ACCESS FOR ALL

We value all voices and take pride in providing relevant resources and a world of opportunities and possibilities for every age and stage of life, ensuring everyone in our community can access the materials and services important to them.

- Offer books through the postal service so that community members who are physically unable to visit the library are still able to access the collection.
- Improve computer accessibility for all, including but not limited to people with disabilities.
- Be a resource for those new to the community by connecting them to resources and services
- Offer a collection which contains a variety of resource types (including but not limited to books and DVDs) as well as a variety of perspectives and reflects the community that we serve.
- Investigate a library app to make browsing the library collection and services accessible for smartphone users.
- Create an updated library website that is accessible for all, visually attractive, and both informative and useful for all community members.
- Offer programs for new members (including English language learners) so that they feel part of a large, welcoming community.
- Offer programs and resources for all ages, beginning at birth, including interactive programming and a variety of types of resources including local park and museum passes.

- Support our children and teens as they develop a lifelong love of language, literature, and learning by providing programs that encourage them to explore a wide range of interests.
- Provide multi-cultural experiences to enhance and enrich our community's knowledge of the world around them.
- Support our most experienced learners by providing interactive, innovative programs which encourage them to explore new and emerging technologies and other topics of interest as well as topics new to them.
