

Wireless Access Policy

Salina Library offers free wireless access to library patrons for use with personal notebooks, laptops, phones, tablets, and other mobile Internet devices. This access point is provided at the user's own risk.

All wireless users are expected to act in a lawful and respectful manner, and are required to conform to the conditions of Salina Library's Internet Access Policy and library Code of Conduct.

Use of the library's wireless network is entirely at the risk of the user. The library disclaims all liability for any information that is compromised or lost through the use of its wireless access. This includes damage or loss due to:

- Electrical surges
- Breaches of security by viruses or hacking
- Disruptions of wireless service

As with most public wireless networks, the library's wireless connection is not secure. Any information being transmitted could potentially be intercepted by another wireless user. Cautious and informed wireless users should not transmit personal information (credit card numbers, passwords, and any other sensitive information) while using any wireless network. Please take appropriate precautions when using this service.

Library staff can provide general information for connecting a device to the wireless network. Staff cannot provide technical assistance in configuring a device or troubleshoot wireless access problems. Salina Library does not guarantee that any given device will work with the library's wireless access.

Access to printing is not available through the wireless connection, however, print jobs may be submitted as an email attachment to a designated library email account and picked up at the circulation desk. Standard computer stations are also available for use with the public printer.
